Most of the tropical fruits that you might find in the grocery store are started from seeds. The seeds require an environment with 24°C (75°F) to germinate. To check if your local environment will allow for this, google “areas” “tropical fruit germination”. When tropical fruit is in season, I try to limit my purchases. I still want to have some available in my freezer and fridge, but I don’t want to buy a whole lot in one trip. When I do go to the grocery store, I like to limit my trip to two items – one for me and one for my son. We have a large mango tree in our backyard.
